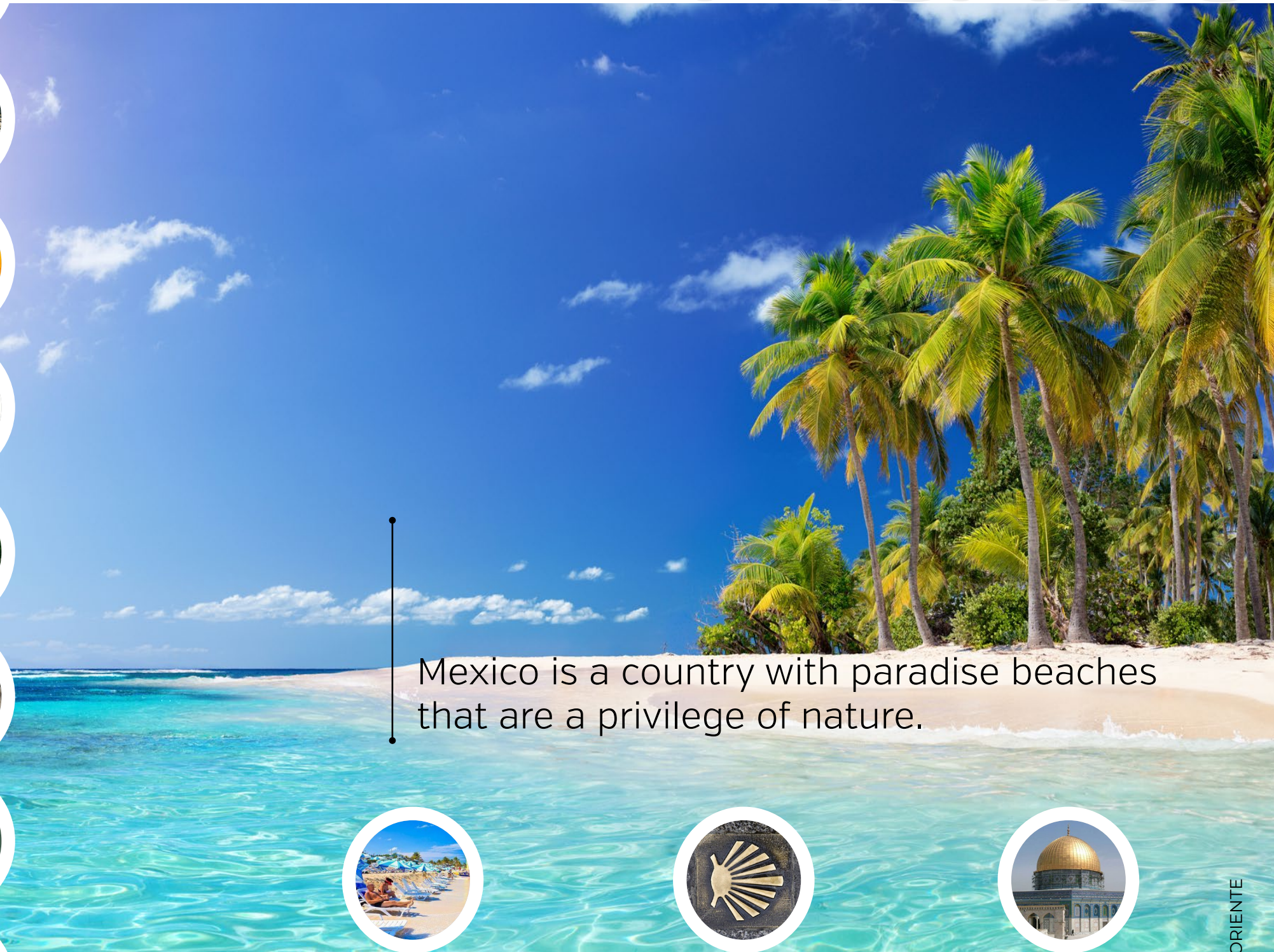

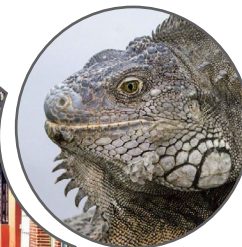

Palenque is a city of Mayan origin located in the state of Chiapas, near the Usumacinta River. In comparison with other Mayan cities, it is considered of medium size: smaller than Tikal or Copán, but it stands out for its architectural and sculptural heritage.

### Uxmal

Uxmal, surrounded by legends, myths and anecdotes; poetic in its name and history, is located in the Santa Elena Valley next to a series of hills known as Puuc, which in the Mayan language means "mountain range," and that was the name later given to the architectural style of the sites in that region. It is estimated that it had a population of about 25 thousand inhabitants.

### Campeche

A fortified city that was besieged by pirates in ancient times for being a strategic port for commercial exchange between Mexico and the old world.

### Villahermosa

It's the capital city of the state of Tabasco, Mexico, there is The Park Museum La Venta is an outdoor museum that holds one of the largest collections of pieces belonging to the Olmec culture.

### Mérida

It is one of the cities in Mexico where you can breathe out tranquility day after day. Founded on the day in 1542 on the remains of the Mayan city called T'Ho. In the year 2000 the city was named American Capital of Culture by virtue of the impulse it has given to cultural activities.

### Chichén Itzá

Chichen Itza Located in Yucatan, named World Heritage Site by UNESCO and considered one of the "New Seven Wonders of the World". Let's visit.

## Querétaro

## Guanajuato

Guanajuato is a Mexican city, capital of the state of the same name. It is in the north-central part of Mexico. Its current name derives from kuanasī=rana uata= hill, being correctly written in Purépecha as Kuanasiuatu, which means "frogs hill ". At the beginning of the 19th century it was the scene of one of the most outstanding insurgent victories.

AMAZING MEXICO

As you enter one of the oldest civilizations on the planet, you will have to sharpen your senses to travel calmly and with an explorer's soul through its archaeological remains and museums.

The Archaeological Zone of Teotihuacan is located in the state of Mexico, it is considered one of the most important pre-Hispanic sites discovered. It is material testimony of one of the best planned and extensive pre-Hispanic cities of the ancient world.

## Cacaxtla-Xochitécatl

Visit the Archaeological Zone of Cacaxtla Known worldwide for the quality of its mural paintings, Cacaxtla is part of an exceptional archaeological site where you can realize the complex traditions that they had.

## Tlachihualtépetl

The Great Pyramid of Cholula or Tlachihualtépetl (from the Nahuatl word "handmade hill") is the largest pyramidal base in the world with 400 meters per side. It is also the largest pyramid in volume with 4,500,000 m<sup>3</sup>, although not in height: it is 65 m high.

## Monte Albán

Declared a World Cultural Heritage Site by UNESCO, it was the ancient ceremonial and military capital of the Zapotecs who settled in the Central Valleys of Oaxaca. Here you will find temples, tombs, patios, the ball game and more.

## Mitla

It is the second ceremonial zone in the Oaxacan territory after Monte Alban. Discover the five monumental architectural sets that this archaeological place has for you. Let's travel to a time of cultural mysticism and live the legacy of these ancient civilizations of ancestral Mexico.



## Aztec Calendar

The Aztec Calendar or Sun Stone is one of the most representative pieces of Mexico. It is a monolithic basalt disc with inscriptions alluding to the Mexica cosmogony and solar cults. The calendar is a systematized account of the passage of time, used for the chronological organization of activities and also was a set of rules or standards.

It is a museum that treasures one of the greatest masterpieces of sculpture belonging to the Olmec culture.

### **Tlaxco**

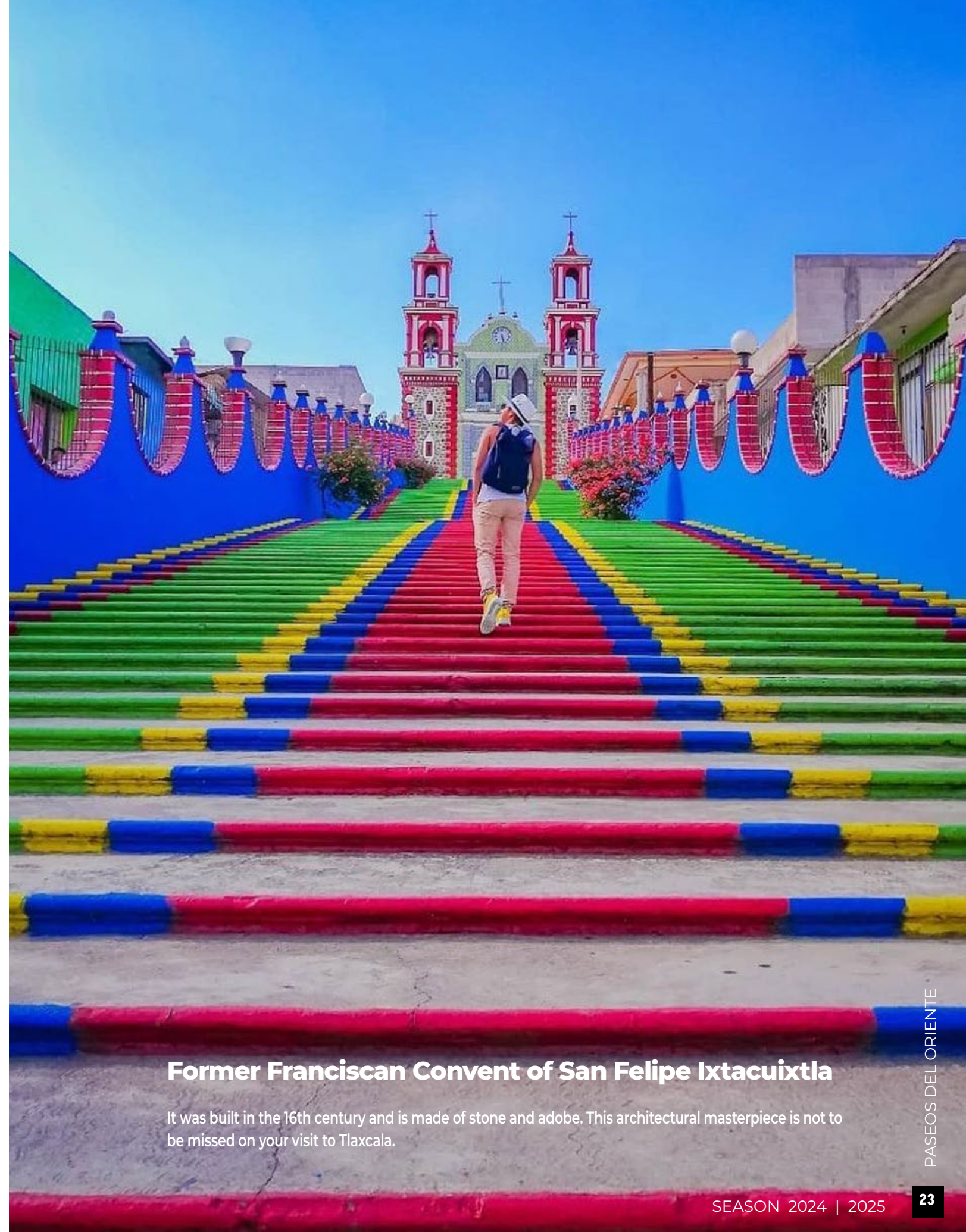

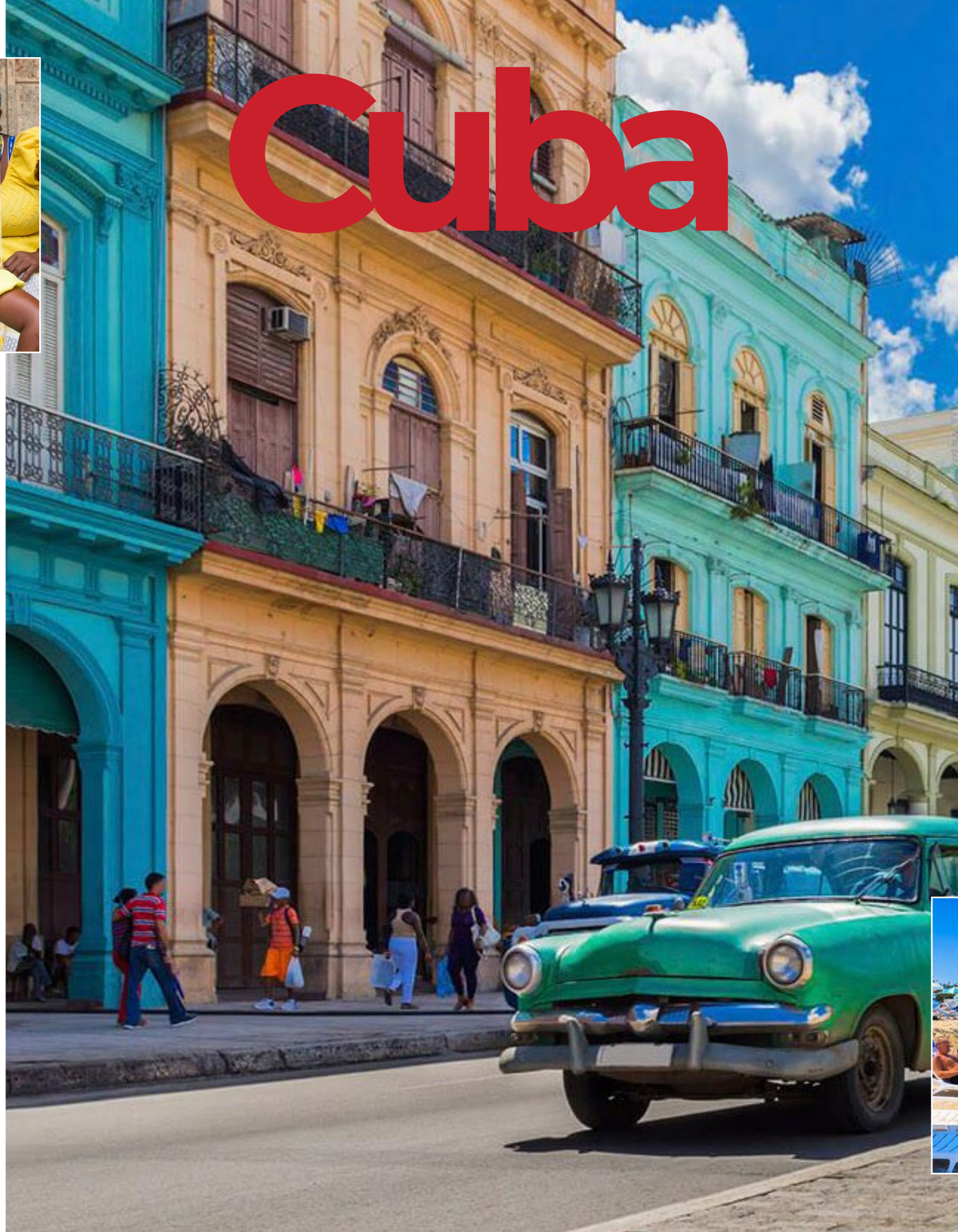
### **Former Franciscan Convent of San Felipe Ixtacuixtla**

# MES Saint JAMES Saint

## LET'S WALK THE WAY OF SAINT JAMES

**There is only one pilgrimage in which the route is as important as the destination, The Way of Saint James, where at the end of the route, according to tradition, the apostle Saint James rests eternally.**

The Way of St. James is a series of Christian pilgrimage routes of medieval origin that lead to the tomb of St. James the Greater, one of the main apostles of Jesus Christ, located in the cathedral of Santiago de Compostela in Galicia, Spain. What is the Way? For more than a thousand years, the Way of St. James has led pilgrims to the shrine of an apostle of Christianity, "Santiago el Mayor". His tomb, discovered one night in 813 on the sacred mountain of Libredón, would be the first stone of a prodigious Cathedral and of a city that since then, would attract walkers and believers, becoming a destination that invites the pilgrim to start walking the old continental paths of the Way of Saint James. This ancient mechanism of common search very typical of Christianity: the journey towards salvation; and it is in this way that the profoundly human experience of self-discovery begins. There are many routes that lead to Santiago and also there are many ways to make a deeper and more personal discovery, which all pilgrims are guaranteed to experience as they advance along the paths of chance encounters or loneliness, of voices and silence, of the dark landscape or the dry plain, in search of a single destination, that of Santiago de Compostela. Since its emergence in the Middle Ages, it has become a remarkable place of meeting and cultural exchange between the people of Europe and other places. On the way you can experience from the immaterial, personal and shared aspects, to the whole set of historical buildings, such as churches, hostels, monasteries, bridges, etc. Let's live a trip to the deepest corners of "being", let's walk the Way of Saint James.



## The Way of Saint James

It is a Christian pilgrimage of medieval origin that its destination is the tomb of the Apostle St. James, located in the cathedral of Santiago de Compostela in Galicia, Spain. It is about walking a path sown with numerous manifestations of fervor, remorse, hospitality, art and culture, which speaks eloquently of the spiritual roots of the Old Continent.

### Gastronomy

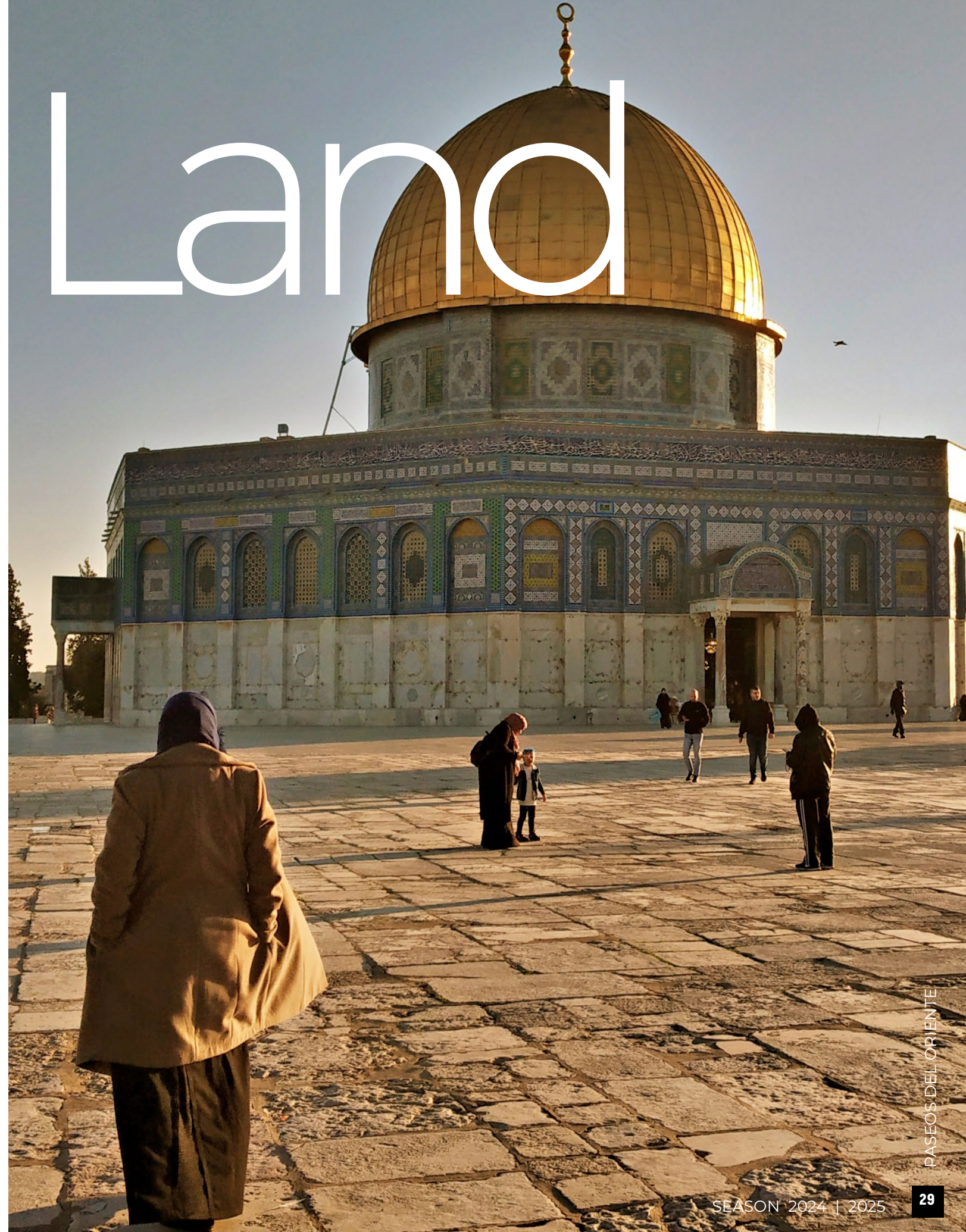

It is an area of small white houses, with a lot of tradition, all of them surrounding the Sanctuary of Nuestra Señora del Rocío, where the Blanca Paloma (White Dove) resides, name given to this Virgin and of which there are thousands of devotees who weekly go to venerate her. During the Pilgrimage of El Rocío, more than a million people visit this place in the province of Huelva to venerate the Virgin.

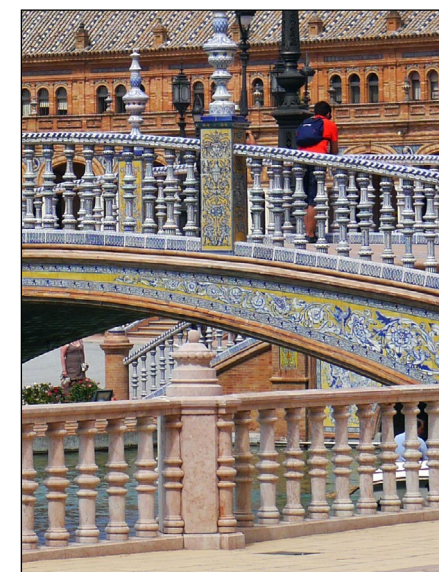
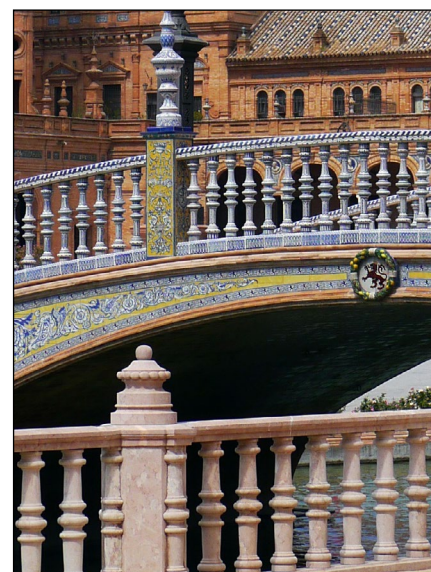

And finally, the extensive Peruvian jungle, with its very tropical vegetation, is crossed by the mighty Amazon River. It is divided into two very different areas: the high jungle or mountain ridge that has

a subtropical and temperate climate and the low jungle, which between April and October, is an ideal time for tourism, with sunny days and high temperatures.

Chavi archaeological complex. Registered in the list of monuments named as world heritage in 1985, the archaeological site of Chavín de Huántar is one of the oldest in America. It is located at 3185 meters above sea level and three hours by highway from the city of Huaraz. Huascarán National Park, is the second highest park in the Andes and also a world heritage site since 1985. Archaeological Zone of Chan Chan, World heritage since 1986. Known internationally as the largest mud city in the pre-Hispanic world, in the Yunga language its name means "sun".



**Visiting:** Historical Center of Lima. Recognized in 1991 as a world heritage site. The Nazca lines, discovered in 1927, are the most important heritage left by the Nazca culture. Historical Center of Arequipa. The Colca Valley is the scene of an impressive number of agricultural terraces dating back to the Inca era. On the Urubamba river, in the Vilcabamba mountains, the Machu Picchu citadel is one of the most important archaeological sites in the world and is the main tourist destination in Peru. 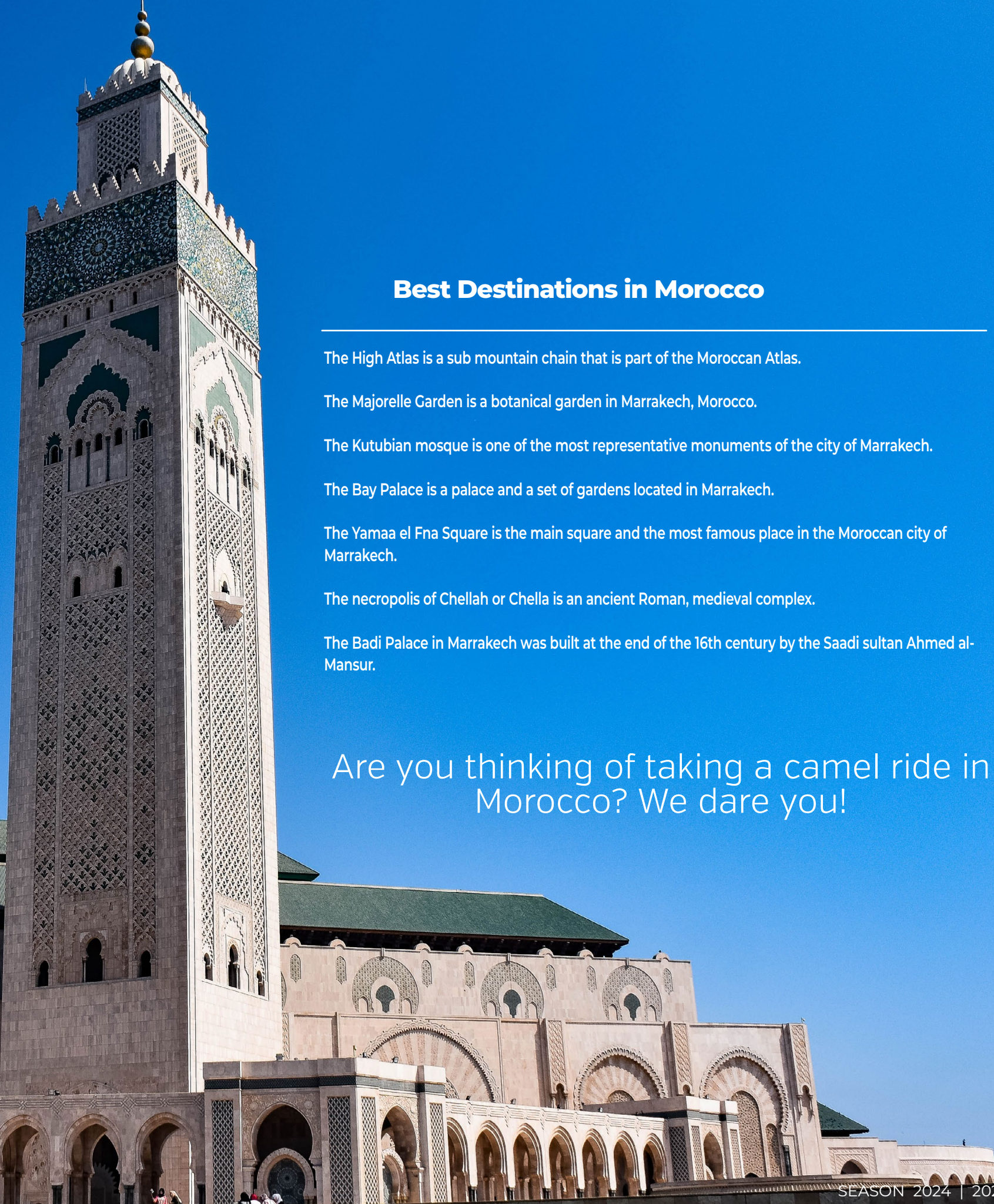

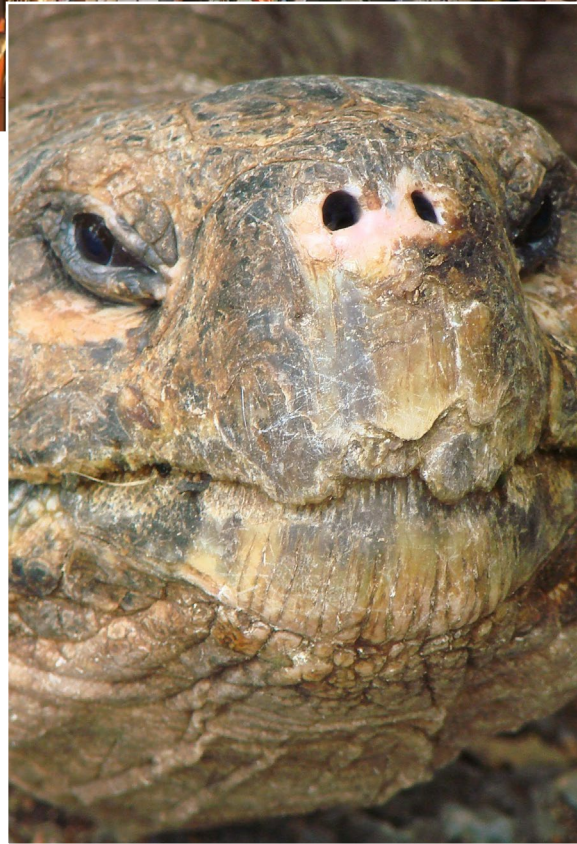

The characteristic deep blue color of its legs comes from the carotenoid pigments that come from its diet. The blue legs that give the name to this variety of gannet and to feed themselves can be submerged up to one meter in the sea.

**Guayaquil** is presented as a pearl on the southern coast of the Pacific, on the banks of the majestic Guayas River where it is crossed by several rivers such as the Salado. "The Pearl of the Pacific", as it is known, has many tourist attractions that will make your visit an unforgettable experience.

Its capital, Quito, is considered a World Cultural Heritage site and has also been named the headquarters of the Union of South American Nations (Unasur). There you can visit a multitude of museums, stroll through the beautiful streets of its historic center and enjoy its fabulous cuisine.

**If you're thrilled by desert landscapes, incredible mountain ranges, historic forts and warm beaches, then make Oman your next destination.**

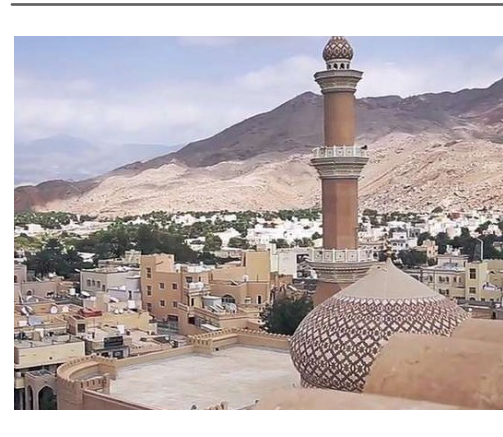

It contains, 1,700,000,000 knots, weighs 21 tonnes and took four years to produce, and brings together the classical Persian Tabriz, Kashan and Isfahan design traditions.
